



Executive Summary

Renewal of Institutional Licensure University College of Mother and Family Sciences

10-13 May 2018

An External Review Team (hereafter ERT) visited the University College of Mother and Family Sciences (UCMFS) from 10 to 13 May 2018 to evaluate its Self-Study (hereafter the *Self-Study*) for Renewal of Institutional Licensure.

UCMFS is a private academic institution that is legally independently and functions in accordance with the provisions of Federal Law No. 4 of 1992. The Bachelor of Arts in Motherhood and Family Science received initial accreditation in 2008 and started to enrol students in 2010. In 2013, UCMFS introduced some changes to improve the program, including reformulating the objectives and outcomes. In addition to diplomas, currently, UCMFS offers three bachelor programs: the Bachelor of Arts in Maternity and Family Sciences - General Track, Bachelor of Arts in Maternity and Family Sciences - Family Counselling Track, and Bachelor of Arts in Maternity and Family Sciences - Women's Rights Track, as well as Diploma of Arts in Maternity and Family Sciences - General Track. All students are female with a current total enrolment of 244 students, while the number of graduates over the past four years has reached 228.

The ERT commends the material resources, technical infrastructure, and training capabilities of UCMFS. On the other hand, the ERT identified areas of improvement mainly related to the Quality Assurance Unit activities and institutional research, the educational programs, and developing an executive plan for scientific research and encouraging it.

The ERT is sure that the college will not hesitate to implement the requirements to bring them to the desired level that achieves the vision of the college's ambitious mission.

The ERT makes its recommendations in a spirit of constructive engagement, with the aim of ensuring that the *Standards* are met, and to aid UCMFS in its desired objective to renew its licensure and achieves its ambitious mission.
